There is one award annually. Nominations will be based on all/some of the following core themes:

Application Criteria:

- The nominee must be an Enrolled Nurse or Registered Nurse in their state/territory.
- The nominee must be employed within one of the 17 ANZBA affiliated burn services.
- The nominees must agree to being actively promoted via the ANZBA newsletters, website and events.
